LOGGING INTO YOUR AICSA ONLINE COURSE


Congratulations on choosing to enrol in an AICSA Online Course!

Step 1

When you select the 'Enrol Now' button you will see the following screen:




Select 'Create new Account' which has been highlighted here in yellow.

Step 2

This page (see below) will appear and you need to complete the required details and then select 'Create my new account'.

Select a Username and Password that you are going to remember. Write it down as you will need it to login next time! When you login next time you will insert your user name and password at the top right hand menu. It is suggested you save the password to your computer.



Step 3


After paying you now have access to your course.
